

Tres Rios Nature and Earth Festival – FAQ Information Sheet

WHEN: March 11-12 , 2012 (Saturday and Sunday), 9 am to 4 pm each day.

WHERE: Estrella Mountain Regional Park – 14805 W. Vineyard, Goodyear, AZ
5 ½ miles South of I-10 off Estrella Pkwy

FOR WHO: This is an event for the whole family. Bring the kids and enjoy the free activities such as our fishing clinic, archery range, canoeing, bird watching and more!

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST: Admission and almost all activities are FREE! Some rides provided by outside vendors have a small fee. \$3 parking fee per vehicle.

FOOD AND DRINK: Various vendors will provide a variety of meal and snack foods for you to purchase.

ARTS AND CRAFTS: Visit with our various vendors to view and purchase their nature, recycling and outdoor arts, crafts and other items.

EXHIBITS: A variety of outdoor, nature and history organizations will have informative exhibits for your viewing. Experts on these topics will be available to answer your questions and tell you about their organizations.

FISHING CLINIC: No license required. Bring your own or use our fishing gear.

CANOEING: Free 15 minute access to canoes to paddle yourself around our safe and wildlife friendly lagoon.

BIRD WATCHING: Take an early morning guided tour of the local bird watching opportunities (pre-registration required – see our website) OR just show up anytime for a chance to bird along our nature trail with an Audubon Society helper. Assistance to beginning birders is their specialty! (Note: Bird Watching gets more difficult during the hot afternoons, try to do this early in the day if possible)

ARCHERY: Visit our beginner archery range and learn about shooting a bow and arrow in a safe setting.
